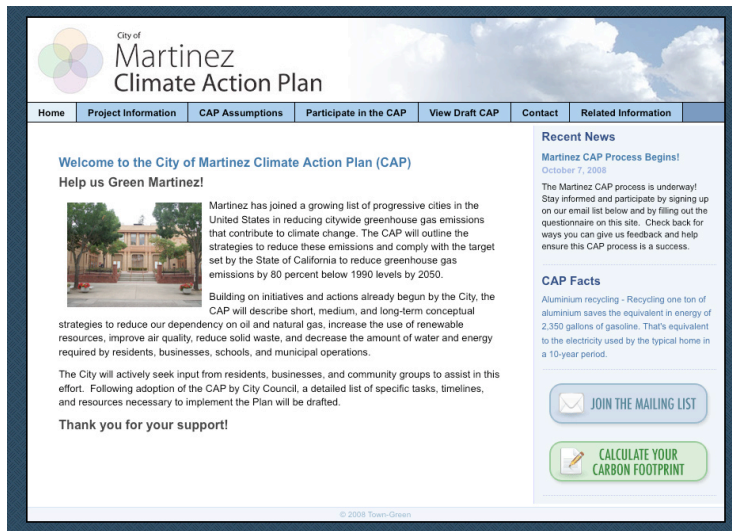


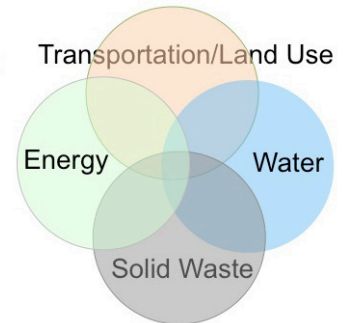

Martinez has joined progressive cities in the United States in reducing citywide greenhouse gas emissions that contribute to climate change. The Climate Action Plan (CAP) will outline the strategies to reduce these emissions and comply with the target set by the State of California to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 80 percent below 1990 levels by 2050.

Building on initiatives and actions already begun by the City, the CAP will describe short, medium, and long-term conceptual goals to reduce our dependency on oil and natural gas, increase the use of renewable resources, improve air quality, reduce solid waste, and decrease the amount of water and energy required by residents, businesses, schools, and municipal operations.

The City will actively seek input from residents, businesses, and community groups to assist in this effort. Following

adoption of the CAP by City Council, a detailed list of specific tasks, timelines, and resources necessary to implement the Plan will be drafted.

Town-Green teamed with ESA, an environmental planning firm, who performed a majority of the environmental research. Town-Green's role includes urban design and land use recommendations, overall approach to the CAP, public facilitation and outreach, and developing a project website that will allow increased communication during the year long planning process.
